Halloween Safety

General Halloween Safety Tips:

- ONLY eat treats with unopened wrappers
- ONLY consume homemade treats from people you know
- Test face paint on a small area of skin before applying to face
- Only use face paint made in the United States prevents lead and mercury exposure
- CALL 1-800-1222 for advice if your child ingests glow stick fluid or if they have a reaction to face paint

Face Paint & Glow Stick Exposures:

Mouth

If swallowed, may see mild mouth irritation, throat irritation, or feel the need to vomit Face paint that is swallowed may discolor poop Okay to drink small sips of water Seek further evaluation if vomiting is severe

Skin

Redness or skin irritation may occur Wash affected area with warm water and mild soap

Eye

Eye redness or irritation may occur Rinse eye for 15 minutes with running water Seek further evaluation if severe eye pain or blurred vision occurs
